Your campground is requested to take part in the *Survey on Occupancy of Québec Campgrounds 2026* conducted by the Institut de la statistique du Québec (ISQ) on behalf of the Ministère du Tourisme. The objective of this survey is to provide indicators that will help plan the actions to be taken to develop all Québec campgrounds.

Given the importance of the survey results, the participation of your campground is **mandatory** in accordance with the *Act respecting the Institut de la statistique du Québec* (CQLR, chapter I-13.011).*

Please note that the months of May and September have been added to the survey this year.

The 2026 edition of the survey covers the reference months of **May**, June, July, August and **September**. Even if your campground is not always open during this period, please complete the online questionnaire within the following dates for each month:

- May: June 1 to 12
- June: June 30 to July 12
- July: July 31 to August 12
- August: September 2 to 9
- September: September 18 to October 7

Starting June 1, go to the web address that will be emailed to you, enter your identifier, and complete the questionnaire. Until then, you can use the attached form to compile your data.

The ISQ will follow up by phone with those who have not submitted their online questionnaire.
