About the study

The *Study on Child Development in a Pandemic Context* aims to collect information on various aspects of children's lives in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic and lockdown measures in order to guide decision-makers regarding services to be put in place to mitigate the negative effects of the health crisis on the future of young Quebecers. It also aims to link this information with the developmental status of children.

This study is being conducted by the Institut de la statistique du Québec on behalf of the Observatory for Children's Education and Health and the Ministère de l'Éducation.

The purpose of the teacher component is to collect information on the developmental status of about 10,000 Grade 5 students who will be selected at random among the children for whom a questionnaire was completed as part of the 2017 *Québec Survey of Child Development in Kindergarten* (QSCDK).

Teachers will be asked to complete a questionnaire about each child in their class who has been selected for the study. The questionnaire will collect information on various aspects of child development.
