



Québec Survey of Child Development in Kindergarten (QSCDK) 2027

Greetings,



The Institut de la statistique du Québec (ISQ) is conducting the fourth edition of the *Québec Survey of Child Development in Kindergarten (QSCDK)*. The results will be used to guide and adjust services for young children in order to better prepare them for school and thus promote their academic success.

This survey stems from a partnership between the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux, the Ministère de l'Éducation, the Ministère de la Famille, the Lucie and André Chagnon Foundation, and the ISQ. Its purpose is to collect data on the development of children in 5-year-old kindergarten. This survey is one of the components of the Joint Intervention Initiative for Early Childhood Development launched in 2011 to support academic success from an early age.

All children in 5-year-old kindergarten in public and private, French- and English-language schools are included in this survey. Teachers have a key role to play—completing a questionnaire for each child in their 5-year-old kindergarten class.

To ensure that the objectives of the survey are met, the ISQ has made the QSCDK **mandatory** in accordance with the *Act respecting the Institut de la statistique du Québec* (CQLR, chapter I-13.011). The participation of teachers in public and private, French- and English-language schools is essential for the ISQ to be able to produce high-quality, reliable data comparable with those from previous survey editions.

You will be invited to complete an online questionnaire that takes about 15 minutes for each child in your 5-year-old kindergarten class.

To complete the questionnaires, you will be released from your teaching duties according to the terms described in the information note available by clicking on the link in the email.

In the email, you will also find documents that describe the survey and explain how to participate. In addition, documents for your students' parents will be sent to you through your school principal.
