## *Growing Up in Québec – School Round*

Greetings,

For several years now, the Institut de la statistique du Québec (ISQ) has been conducting a large study of children born in Québec. Called *Growing Up in Québec*, this study aims to better understand the development of children through annual visits with them.

### **Why am I receiving this letter?**

This year, the study includes a questionnaire for the teachers of the participating children. In addition, these children's parents will be given the possibility of having an ISQ interviewer meet with their child at school to do activities and complete a questionnaire with them. You are receiving this letter because at least one participating child goes to your school. The parents were informed that we would contact their child's school.

### **What do I have to do as the school director?**

We are asking you to provide us with the contact details of the participating children's homeroom teachers (first and last name, work email address and work phone number). These contact details will be used to send them a questionnaire to be completed outside of work hours. The teachers' participation is voluntary.

## **Additional information**

### **What is the *Growing Up in Québec* study?**

This study aims to better understand the factors that influence children's well-being and development. Thousands of families across the province are taking part in the study. The School Round will help us reach this objective by providing us with information on the participating children's experiences in school.

### **How did you obtain my school's contact information?**

This contact information was obtained in accordance with the *Act respecting the Institut de la statistique du Québec*. The parents were informed that we would contact their child's school.

### **Next steps**

In the spring of 2025, your school may be contacted to organize an appointment between an ISQ interviewer and the children participating in the study. The school visit should last about 60 minutes and will be planned with you if the parent chooses this option.

### **Are teachers obligated to participate in this study?**

The participation of teachers outside of working hours is voluntary, but recommended. We will invite teachers to answer a 30-minute online questionnaire for each participating child in their class, and they will receive \$20 per completed questionnaire.

### **Who are the partners of the study?**

This study is funded by the Lucie and André Chagnon Foundation, the Ministère de la Famille, the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux, the Ministère de l'Éducation, the Ministère du Travail, de l'Emploi et de la Solidarité sociale, the Conseil de gestion de l'assurance parentale, and the Institut de la statistique du Québec.
