## **Additional information**

### **Why was I chosen for the survey?**

You were selected at random, just like several thousand other Quebecers, to participate in the *Québec Public Service Job Attractiveness Survey*.

We obtained the personal information needed for the survey, including your contact information, from the Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec (RAMQ), under an agreement approved by the Commission d'accès à l'information in accordance with the *Act respecting Access to documents held by public bodies and the Protection of personal information*.

### **Do I have to take part in the survey?**

Your participation in the survey is voluntary, but **very important**, since it will make it possible to compare the level of attractiveness of jobs in the private and the public sector, to find out how well known the Québec public service hiring processes are, and to improve these processes if need be.

### **Quality monitoring**

For quality and training purposes, telephone conversations with Statistique Québec agents are recorded. However, if you do not want the conversation to be recorded, simply notify the agent at the beginning of the call.

### **Confidentiality and data transmission**

This survey is being conducted in accordance with the *Act respecting the Institut de la statistique du Québec*. Statistique Québec has signed an agreement with the Secrétariat du Conseil du trésor and the École nationale d'administration publique, to whom the information collected will be sent, with the exception of your name, address, and telephone number. All of your information will be kept **confidential** and will only be used for statistical purposes.

### **Ethics**

The study was reviewed by an ethics committee appointed by Statistique Québec. The ethics committee is responsible for safeguarding the respect, dignity and integrity of those participating or included in the survey.
